A summer of progress and connection at Dublin Airport

A year ago, we celebrated the 10th anniversary of Dublin Airport's 10th birthday. As we enter the peak of what promises to be the busiest summer ever in Dublin Airport's history, it's time to look back on the progress we've made and the connections we've built.

With more than 10 million people expected to travel through Dublin Airport this summer, our passenger focus is clear: delivering a smooth, efficient, and enjoyable experience for every family and traveller. This means at least 100,000 of passengers clearing security in under 20 minutes, just as they do.

It also means a renewed focus on the basics and a commitment to continuous improvement. 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Fingal Community Survey Report

Key Findings



Strong support for Dublin Airport



8 in 10 Fingal residents (**82%**) support the development of Dublin Airport.



Economic benefits clearly recognised

86%

86% agree the airport supports economic growth & supports local jobs.



Positive sentiment is rising



Almost **2 in 3** residents (**65%**) feel positive about the airport locally.



Negative sentiment remains very low (**4%**).

Areas to Improve



Clearer communication



Close to **3 in 10** residents (**28%**) feel communication on local issues is unclear.



Around **1 in 5** (**19%**) want greater openness and transparency.



Community responsiveness



Nearly **1 in 5** residents (**18%**) feel the airport is not responsive enough.



Aircraft Noise



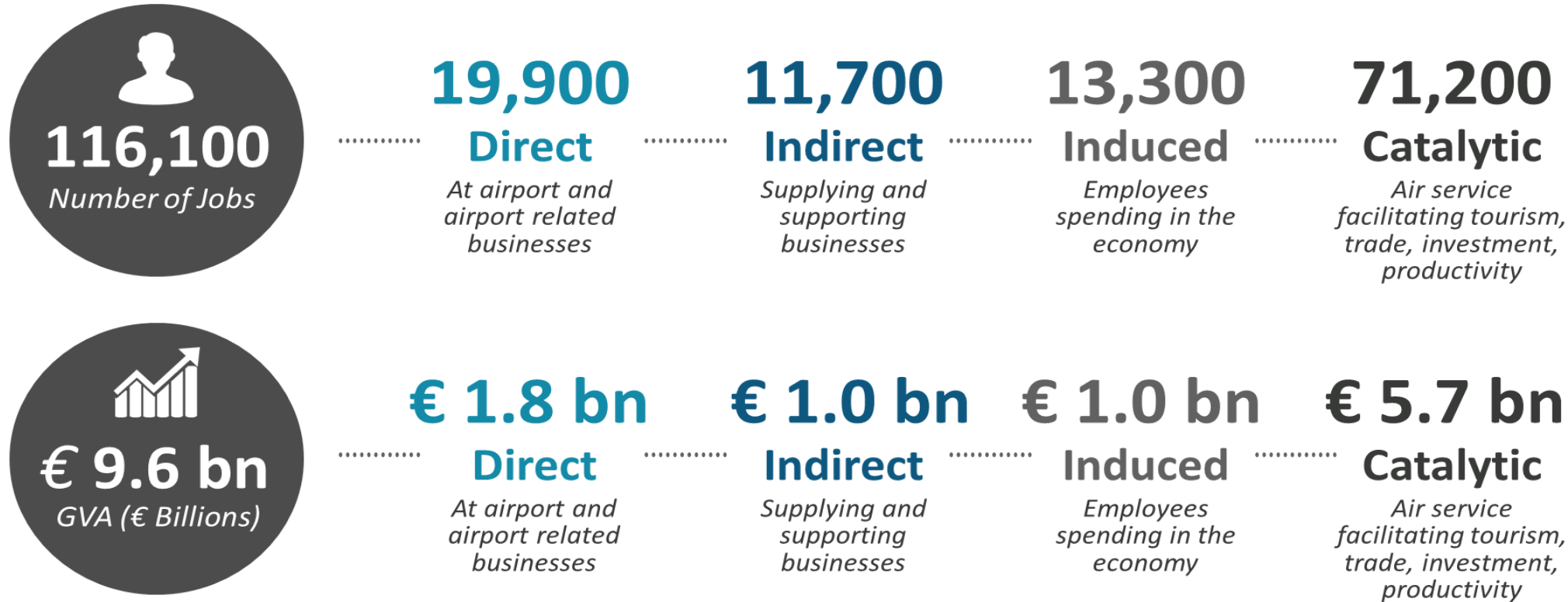
While **1 in 4** residents (**25%**) don't notice any aircraft noise, most describe it as a small amount (**44%**) or medium amount (**19%**), with a minority (**11%**) noticing a large amount.



Overall support for Dublin Airport in Fingal is strong and growing, with communication and engagement the main opportunities.

Methodology: The survey was conducted by Red C Research in May, September and December 2025. Research carried out among over 2000 Fingal residents aged 18+.

Economic Impact of Dublin Airport



19,900 direct jobs – approximately the same as the combined employment of Apple (6,000) Google (5,000), Intel (4,900) and Facebook (3,000) in Ireland.

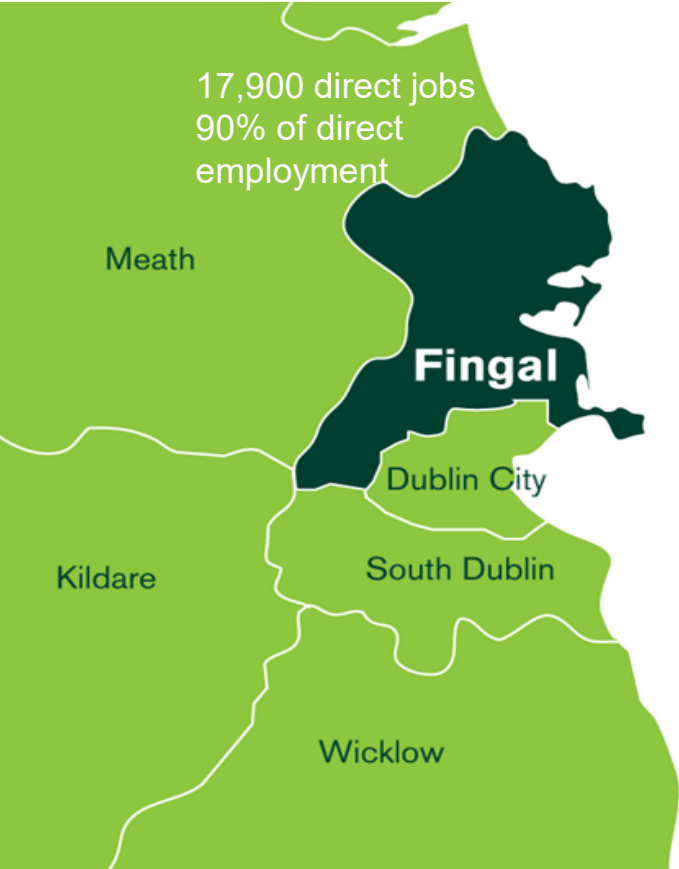

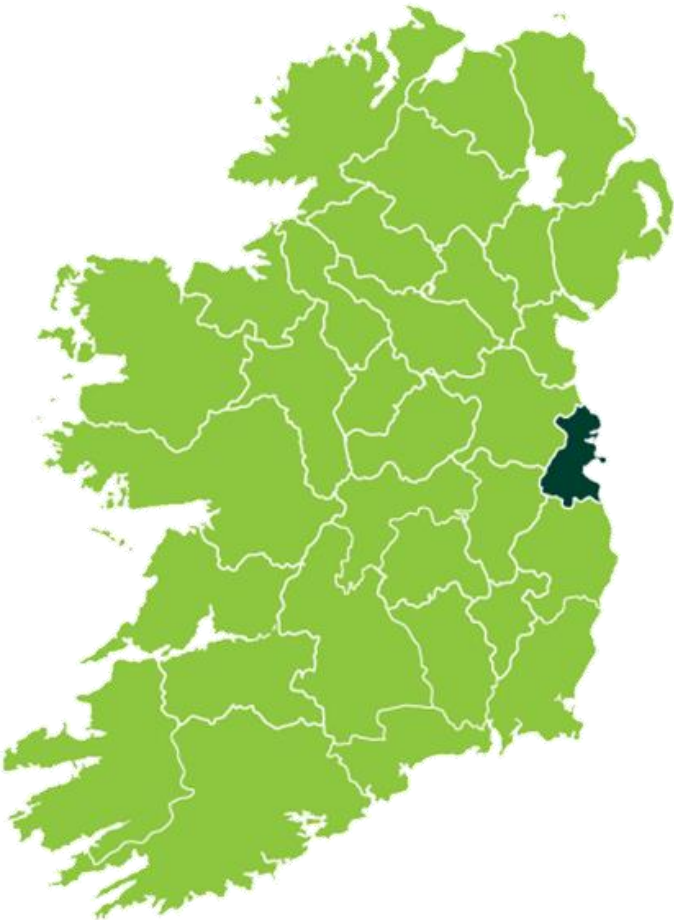

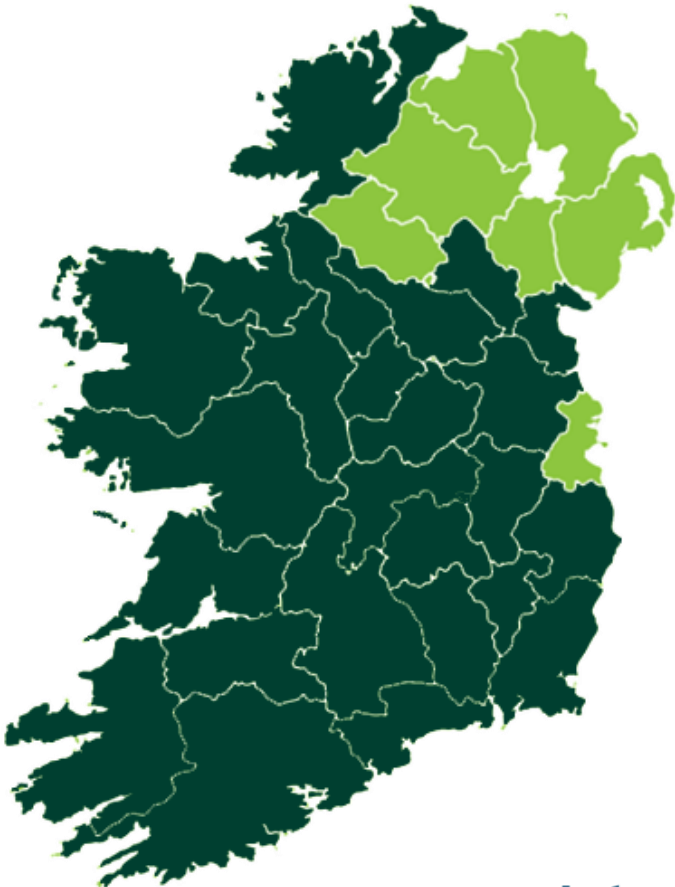
